Position Description

The pharmacist will also participate in program development to ensure BCFHT services meet the needs of our patient populations. - Provide direct and indirect pharmacy services to BCFHT patients
- Perform patient medication reviews and assessments
- Provide medication consultations to patients

- Provide education and guidance to team members regarding drug-related inquiries
- Inform team members of important updates pertaining to drugs and prescribing methods
- Foster an environment of safe medication practices by raising awareness in the community about medication adherence issues and safe medication use
